CONCEPTU MARIS A2 DELIVERABLES

EcoOcéan Institut with the joint work of ISPRA, the project partners and the support and guidance of the AB, concluded the **A2 DELIVERABLES**: two major documents that set the bases of a coordinated, collaborative, multidisciplinary, and effective methodologic work among researchers.

First draft protocol data collection&analysis







The A2 Deliverables include the following main sessions:

- A2.1 Protocol Data Collection: first draft protocol for data collection (subdivided for: visual data collection, eDNA data collection, SIA data collection, Guideline for visual data collection, Practicalities for multidisciplinary data collection);
- A2.2 Indicators, tests, important sites: first draft protocol for data analysis (including five new testing of indicators for the assessment of species under the Habitat Directive requirements using the previews collected FLT Med Net dataset on fin whale, loggerhead sea turtle, striped dolphin, and the squid eater cetacean species Risso's dolphin, long-finned pilot whale and Cuvier's beaked whale);
- the indicators tested within the "A2 First draft protocol data collection & analysis" were chosen based on the review and investigation performed for the "A2.3 Synthesis of available indicators, approaches, potential thresholds and data needed by the different legal framework for CEPTU species status assessment".

CONCEPTU MARIS E-LEARNING COURSE

CIMA finished and put online on its web page the E-learning training course, specifically studied for the crew and the personnel of main shipping companies navigating in the Mediterranean Sea. The course deals with the importance of Mediterranean sea, from an ecological and biodiversity point of view, collision risk between large vessels and CEPTU species, and importance of marine biodiversity monitoring.

The course is hosted in the E-learning platform of CIMA Research Foundation.





CONCEPTU'S COMMUNICATION PLAN




