project, following four years of intensive work

the conservation of **cetaceans and marine
turtles in the Mediterranean Sea.**



LOOKING BACK, MOVING FORWARD

The conclusion of LIFE Conceptu Maris naturally carries a sense of nostalgia: years spent at sea, data collection, scientific exchange and meetings that helped build a community of shared expertise and vision.



At the same time, this is a moment of **synthesis and renewal**. The results achieved do not end with the project itself; rather, they provide a **solid foundation** on which to continue developing research, conservation and public engagement activities.

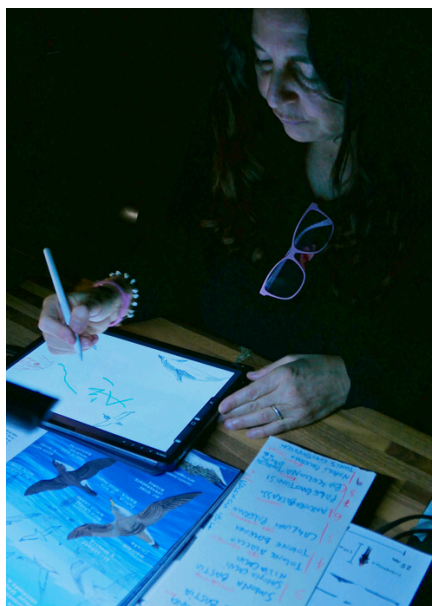
